

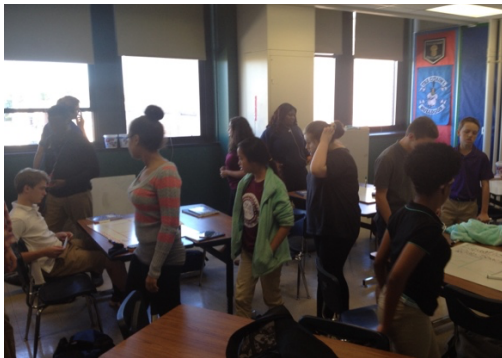
Gallery Walk

Purpose: To share ideas with a presentation or poster or give feedback about other teams' presentations or posters

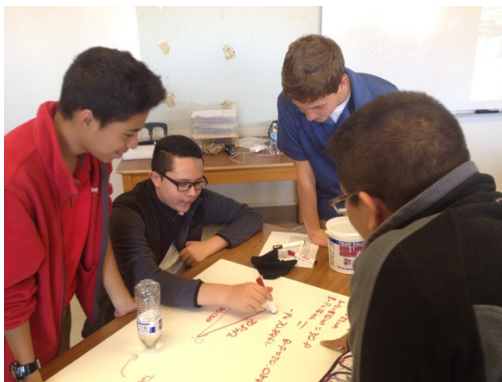
If students appear to be slowing down or stuck, you can call for a one-minute gallery walk.

Types:

1. Gallery Walk – Students walk around for one minute looking at the other team work. They may talk.



2. Museum Walk – This is the same as a gallery walk but there is no talking.
3. Modified Gallery Walk – (I need a better name for this.). Same as the others except one person remains to explain the board. This is good when the problem is so open that a casual observer may not understand the board.



Options:

- Students could give feedback (I usually don't do this.)
- Students could write comments on a notebook (Two Stars and a Wish)
- Teams could stay together and rotate through the boards.
